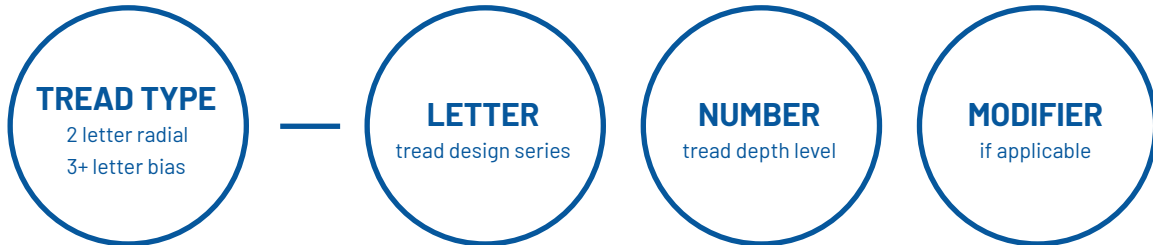




GOODYEAR OFF-THE-ROAD TIRE NAMING FACTSHEET

Radial

- **AS** – All-Season
- **AT** – All-Terrain
- **EV** – Elevator
- **GP** – General Purpose
- **GT** – General Traction
- **RH** – Rock Haul
- **RL** – Rock Lug
- **RM** – Rock Mining
- **RP** – Rock Performance
- **RT** – Rock Traction
- **SG** – Sure Grip
- **TL** – Traction Lug

Bias

- **ELV** – Elevator
- **GGL** – Grader Grip Lug
- **GRL** – Grader Rock Lug
- **HRL** – Hard Rock Lug
- **NRL** – Nylosteel Rock Lug
- **RKMS** – Rock Mine Service
- **SGG** – Sure Grip Grader
- **SGL** – Sure Grip Lug
- **SMO** – Smooth
- **SRB** – Sand Rib
- **UMS** – Underground Mine Service
- **XTR** – Xtra Traction
- **XTRWL** – Xtra Traction Wide Lug

TREAD DEPTH LEVELS

- **3** – 100 Level
- **4** – 150 Level
- **5** – 250 Level

MODIFIERS

- “Gen” + Roman Numeral – the next generation of that tread design series (e.g., EV-5S Gen II)
- Plus(+) – recognized as deeper than the tread depth level but not deep enough to meet the next tread depth level (e.g., TL-3A+)

TIRE NAME EXAMPLES

- **Rock Lug:** RL-4K, RL-4J, HRL-3A
- **Rock Traction:** RT-3B, RT-4A+
- **Elevator:** EV-4K, EV-5S, ELV-3A
